Dear Bro. Mitcox

Mr Chamberlain, having chartered a vessel to go for yourself & family, and having informed me that she will sail this afternoon, I sit down to say 'aloha' and give you an invitation to come to Honolulu and make a visit. It seems by the letters that you wish to come, either to Lahaina or this place, but as the vessel is chartered for the voyage to Milo and Honolulu, there will be no reason why you should not come directly here, and defer your visit there until general meeting, if we have one.

As to accommodations, I cannot point you to any in particular, but we have considerable room in the neighborhood and can doubtless find enough for you. Our Dohi house would be at your service, were it not used for the children's school. You may be assured however that any thing which it may be in the power of either Mr Judd or myself to do for your comfort we shall take a pleasure in doing.
