me ke mataala. He 78 anaina Kula Sabati,
he 50 anaina pule; i kahi wa mai, he 68
Kula Sabati, he 46 anaina pule. Mahinahou,
he (4) eha dala ke kiekie loa, emi mai
3, 2, 1.55 i kahi wa. He ikaika no wau
me ke kono Kauhale me ke lona pu ana
me na hoahana. Ke malama nei au i
ka waiwai o ke ekalesia, a na nui loa
ke mahalo o na hoahana no ia man hana

 Opahikao he 16 a oi a emi i kekahi wa.
 A ma Kamaili mai e loa ana iau he
 36 a oi a emi mai i kekahi wa. A he
 emakemake nui mai kana ka me ke ohohia
 Koe wale iho no keia, o ke Kua Kawalawala
 o Kauhale iuka i o a i o. Ke ua mai,
 ua hiki hapa mai i ika pule. No Kalapana
