I have time to write but a few lines. I send you some seeds which I suppose will grow at your Station. We received two mails from Tili on Saturday, and one from Huaruwa. Br. Landore is going to build on the shore. ~~He~~ We have heard from Brs Pondel and Gies at Harae. Letters do me as much good as visits formerly did and I hope we shall often write to each other and stimulate each other in the good work before us. I have been in the school the past week half a day and Mr. P. the other half and expect after I become settled to go in all day. This week is our examinations. Next week we all expect to go to Huaruwa to visit the schools there. Give my love to Brs Sisters Andrews and the other Brethren and Sisters. Mr. P. sends his love but has not time to write.
