

Waiali June 27th 1849

Dear husband

The Remond came in on Saturday at about noon or a little later than ashore a lot of heavy lumber the boys were off on a "picnic excursion" - Conr. went down and saw a lot of lumber and told me that Edmonds never had posts bed come, he got up & a team and went after it - When I saw the first load I told that it was not the lumber that E. expected but he said it all bed A.W. on it. Mr. S. came about at night and looked it over - said it is marked S. K. some A.W. and on one piece S.H. and D.H. but they say he found D.W. on all - & it was rubbed off ^{the} ~~one~~ in drawing up. The Remond was off to Hilo at day light this morning so we can make no inquiry of the left on "Superior" E. thinks some of going to Hilo to see writing to be ready for him if he concluded to go, Mason & Emily back with Blame Armstrong and George Dole came over

last week, & made a short visit, - and Mr & B. Kier and children and Martha Lander and coming the last of next week, & am getting ready for them to entertain them here. The fathoms are running over full with girls - There are 9 sticks of the Sabbath in all - The Sabbath School celebration comes off wednesday the 13th

We are all well and shall be glad to see you when he comes & I fear the baby will forget you if you stay much longer

I will I believe & most willingly follow the fashion and wear hoop hoops please ask Mrs Lander to select ^{for} me such as she means or what will be suitable for me - let ~~it~~ ^{them} be of the kind that can be enlarged or made smaller at my pleasure
