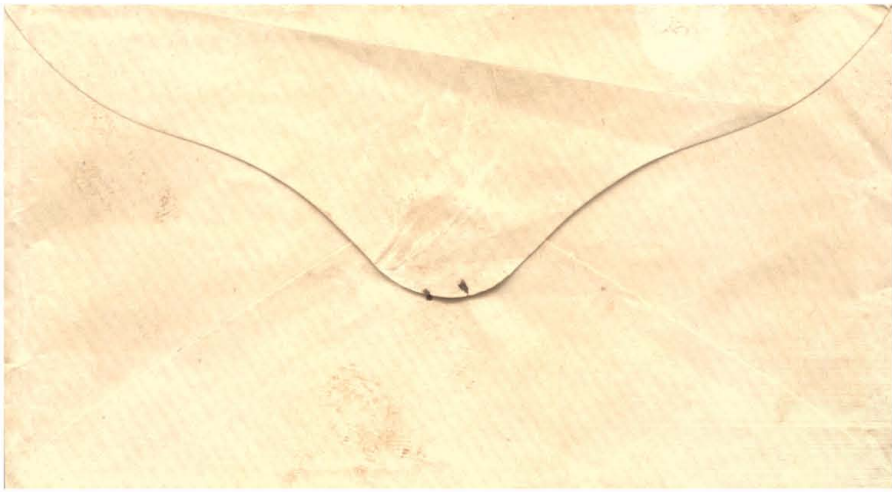

Dear husband

The Keoni Stone came in on Saturday and about noon or a little later then a horse a lot of heavy lumber the boys were off on a "picnic excursion" - Some went down and saw a lot of lumber and told me that Edmonds remembered posts had come, he got up a team and went after it - When I saw the first load I told that it was not the lumber that E. offered but he said it all had A.W. on it, When E. came up at night - I looked it over - some it is marked S. K. some A.W. and on one piece S.K. and A.W. but the boys say he found A.W. on all - I it was rubbed off on ^{the end} in drawing up - The Keoni Stone was off to Kahlia at daylight this morning so we can make no inquiry of the Capt. or Supercargo E. thinks some of going to Kahlia as I am writing to be ready for him if he concludes to go, Marnie & Emily Rice with Clara Armstrong and George Cole came over
