My dear sir,

We cannot possibly state with any precision at what time you will be called to embark, but very probably not before November or December, possibly not so soon. There must be two companies. Soon after the meeting of the Board, I can no doubt give you more precise information. Should the churches be slow in increasing our receipts, (which I pray God may not be the case,) that must inevitably delay your departure. Meanwhile keep me informed where a letter will find you. You will of course delay your marriage till the time of sailing is both fixed & near. You will need a passport from the Secretary of State at Washington.
