on this event - We hear no particulars
- no letters from Kauai for a short
age - but hope that ere this you are
quite well & enjoying much in this
new treasure -

for that is a scarce commodity in
this region - besides I am quite busy
for time this morn - We are all pretty
well - tho' I am not strong - Our young
boy is full of mischief &c. as any lit-
tle rogue ever was - & with poor health
help I find my hands full from day
to day -
